



Hazel Mackin Community Library YA Mural Painting Competition Rules and Guidelines:

Theme:

The mural will be a part of the redecorated Young Adult section of the library, with the theme of:

“A reader lives a thousand lives before he dies. The man who never reads lives only one” –George R.R. Martin

The above quote will be added to the wall in vinyl, the exact color and placement will be left up to the winning artist’s discretion in order to best fit within the mural design.

Entry Period:

The Hazel Mackin Community Library will begin accepting submissions for its Mural Painting Competition on Monday, January, 14th, 2019 at 10am. **Final designs must be submitted by Monday, February, 11th, 2019.**

Eligibility:

The competition is open to all St. Croix Central District, high school aged students. Students have the option of submitting an individual or group design. **The winning artist will earn volunteer hours for their time spent painting the mural at the library.**

Rules of Entry:

The Hazel Mackin Community Library is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, or misdirected entries. Submissions will not be returned.

General:

Hazel Mackin Community Library reserves the right to cancel, suspend, and/or modify the competition or any part of it. Hazel Mackin Community Library reserves the right to disqualify any entry if it finds the entry to be in violation of the rules of the competition.

Submission Requirements:

Submissions must be original artwork, and must incorporate the quote from the theme section of this page. Entry forms may be picked up at the library circulation desk or downloaded from the library website (www.robertpubliclibrary.org). **All submissions must be returned to the circulation desk, or submitted by email to fahrenkamp@robertpubliclibrary.org by 6pm, Monday, February, 11th, 2019.**

Painting supplies, including paint, brushes, and tarps will be supplied by the library.

Winner Notification:

The winner will be announced in March, through the library's website, Facebook, and Instagram, as well as local newspapers. The winner will be notified no later than Monday, March 11th, 2019.

Agreement to Rules:

By entering the competition, all parties fully agree to and accept the rules as outlined herein and agree to accept the decisions of the Hazel Mackin Community Library. **If selected, you will be required to have your finished design painted on the mural wall no later than May 10th, 2019.**

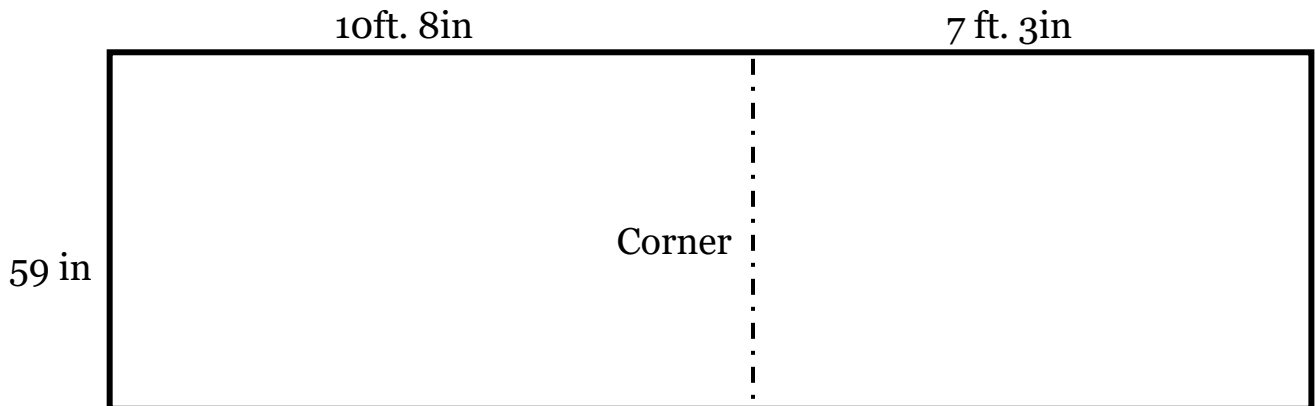
